



GLOBAL WORKS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Global Works Scholarship Program is designed for students who, due to financial reasons, might not have the opportunity to participate in a Global Works program. With the belief that diversity strengthens our group experience, we provide a number of scholarships each year for deserving candidates. Scholarships are awarded on the following criteria:

- **Student need**
- **Student merit**
- **Space availability**

Scholarship Process : To apply for any Global Works scholarship, you must first submit a Scholarship Application, Application for Enrollment, and a \$600 deposit. Deposit checks are not cashed until after you have accepted a position, and deposits will be returned immediately should you choose to decline an offering.

Scholarship Types:

Type A: We offer a limited number of **\$500.00 scholarships to be credited towards a specific program of your choice.** These scholarships are offered on a rolling admissions basis after submitting a scholarship application and \$600 deposit.

Type B: We offer a limited number of **half price scholarships** on programs where we have late openings late in the enrollment season. The disadvantage is that you may not have a choice where scholarships are offered. We do ask for your first three choices in hopes that one of these may have availability in May. Applications and deposits must be received before April 30th. Applications will be contacted and scholarships will be granted after May 9th.

Type C: Each summer we offer **two full scholarships** (one male and one female) for students whose parents' combined income is less than \$30,000. Students who apply for this scholarship should submit their parents' most recent federal tax return in addition to the Scholarship Application and Application for Enrollment. While the deposits are not required in advance, scholarship recipients will be asked to raise their own funds to pay for their own airfare. Applications and deposits must be received before April 30th. Applications will be contacted and scholarships will be granted after May 9th.

1. Fill out the Scholarship Application and check which type of scholarship you are applying for.
2. Fill out the normal Application for Enrollment available in the brochure or on our website.
3. Send them both in along with the \$600 deposit to the address below.
